Body Recovery on Lake Elizabeth

(Twin Lakes) On Friday, July 23, 2010 at 8:30PM the Twin Lakes Police Department Dispatch Center received a 9-1-1 call from a citizen reporting a possible body floating in Lake Elizabeth.

Police and Fire personnel responded to the northwest side of Lake Elizabeth where the caller directed them and recovered the body of John A. Jones, a 53 year old Elgin, Illinois man who was seen by witnesses in distress while in the water on Thursday, July 22, 2010 around 5:00PM.

A multi-jurisdictional MABAS alarm went out to agencies in Illinois and Wisconsin, as dive and sonar teams responded and conducted an extensive water search and recovery operations on Thursday night and Friday with negative results.

The body was released to the Kenosha County Medical Examiner.

The drowning is being investigated by the Twin Lakes Police Department.
